

NFP Scholarship Program FAQ

Where can I find the NFP Scholarship Program application?

When is the application deadline?

March 31, 2024.

What are the eligibility requirements for NFP scholarships?

Applicants should have a minimum of 3.0 GPA and be able to attest to financial need. Current college students must be enrolled full-time in an accredited school located in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and pursuing a degree in the nursing field. Current high school students must be matriculated full-time in an accredited school located in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and pursuing a degree in the nursing field by the upcoming fall semester.

If I live outside of Pennsylvania, am I eligible to apply for an NFP scholarship?

Yes, applicants who reside outside of Pennsylvania are eligible to apply, providing they are currently enrolled in or accepted into a nursing school located within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

If I am currently enrolled in or plan to attend a nursing school located outside of Pennsylvania, am I eligible to apply for an NFP scholarship?

No.

Can any nursing student apply?

NFP scholarships are earmarked for students pursuing the following degrees:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN), including RN-BSN
- Master of Science in Nursing (MSN)
- Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) or PhD candidates



What supporting documents are required as part of the application process?

In addition to the completed application form, applicants are required to provide a current official transcript, a personal photo, and a letter of reference. Optional documentation that attests to the applicant's financial need may also be submitted. Complete instructions for document submission, including steps for having materials submitted on the applicant's behalf by a third-party, are found in the application.

Does the application include essays?

Yes, applicants are required to respond to two essay prompts.

If I already received a scholarship from NFP, am I eligible to reapply again this year?

Students who have previously received a scholarship through NFP are welcome to apply again.
